

Parish Registration: To register in one of our cluster parishes, please pick up a registration form at Mass and turn it in to the parish office, or contact your parish office directly.

Baptism: For infants and children under the age of 7: a pre-baptismal preparation process for parents is required, and the sacrament is celebrated on a scheduled basis. Please contact your Deacon to register for preparation.

RCIA (**Becoming Catholic**): The RCIA process is for unbaptized persons, ages 7 and older, and those who were baptized in another Christian tradition. The process is one of conversion and formation and people are welcomed into the process year-round. Contact one of our Deacon's for more information.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at St. Joseph on Wednesdays: 5pm & Saturdays: 3-3:45pm, St. Vincent on Wednesdays: 12:30 & Saturdays: 3:30pm and St. Mary's on Sundays: 8:45-9:15am.

Anointing of the Sick: Celebrated after masses when requested or by appointment.

Marriage: Engaged couples should contact the parish at least six months in advance of a desired wedding date.

Jeremiah speaks of a joyful future awaiting those Israelites who were in captivity in Babylon. What are some things you are looking forward to with joy?





All Saints' and All Souls' Day Masses: All Saints' Day, Friday, Nov. 1st, is a holy day of obligation. St. Vincent's Mass will be at 6pm.

On **All Souls' Day,** Sat., Nov. 2, St. Vincent will celebrate Mass at 12 noon, but please note: this Mass does not fulfill your weekend Mass obligation.

2024 Downtown Christmas Toiletry, Socks and Glove Request: It is hard to believe but we are beginning to prepare for the Downtown Christmas. Each year, for the last **38 years**, we have provided Christmas gifts for our Backdoor guests and families in need.
