

Parish Registration: To register in one of our cluster parishes, please pick up a registration form at Mass and turn it in to the parish office, or contact your parish office directly.

Baptism: For infants and children under the age of 7: a pre-baptismal preparation process for parents is required, and the sacrament is celebrated on a scheduled basis. Please contact your Deacon to register for preparation.

RCIA (**Becoming Catholic**): The RCIA process is for unbaptized persons, ages 7 and older, and those who were baptized in another Christian tradition. The process is one of conversion and formation and people are welcomed into the process year-round. Contact one of our Deacon's for more information.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at St. Joseph on Wednesdays: 5pm & Saturdays: 3-3:45pm, St. Vincent on Wednesdays: 12:30 & Saturdays: 3:30pm and St. Mary's on Sundays: 8:45-9:15am.

Anointing of the Sick: Celebrated after masses when requested or by appointment.

Marriage: Engaged couples should contact the parish at least six months in advance of a desired wedding date.

Bulletin: Submissions for bulletin must be submitted to Kim Primo ten days prior to the first date of inclusion. Bulletin items will be included two weeks prior to event with advanced notice included 2 months prior. All submissions subject to approval/editing.

Clothes Closet: In the month of December, 100+ persons were helped. We are currently in need of Men's underwear-sizes medium, large and extra-large, Woman's underwear sizes L and XL, Jeans (sizes 32 & 34 waist), and, as always, sneakers. Thank you to everyone for your generosity to the clothes closet in 2024; you helped us to help many.

Food Pantry: In December, 22 families (63 people) and 96 homeless were served. The total number of individuals served by the pantry was 159. The pantry is currently in need of fruit cups, crackers, mayo, and "pull-top" containers of chicken, tuna, Vienna sausages, etc. and donations of toilet paper. We wish to thank everyone who contributed in 2024 and to all who are continuing to contribute in this new year.

Back Door Ministry: The backdoor of St. Vincent's kitchen served lunch 882 guests in December. The number of individuals coming to us for lunch continues to remain high, versus this time last year.
