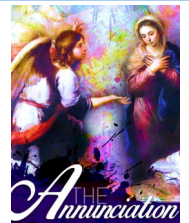

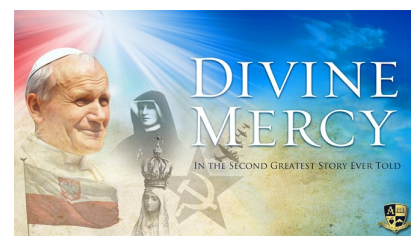
**Cluster Lenten Mission:** *Hope Amid Suffering*, March 24-26 at Saint Joseph. 6pm potluck, 7pm presentation.

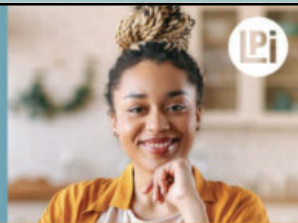
