

Parish Registration: To register in one of our cluster parishes, please pick up a registration form at Mass and turn it in to the parish office, or contact your parish office directly.

Baptism: For infants and children under the age of 7: a pre-baptismal preparation process for parents is required, and the sacrament is celebrated on a scheduled basis. Please contact your Deacon to register for preparation.

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults) The OCIA process is for unbaptized persons, ages 7 and older, and those who were baptized in another Christian tradition. The process is one of conversion and formation and people are welcomed into the process year-round. Contact one of our Deacon's for more information.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at St. Joseph on Wednesdays: 5pm & Saturdays: 3-3:45pm, St. Vincent on Wednesdays: 12:30pm & Saturdays: 3:30pm and at St. Mary's on Sundays: 8:45-9:15am.

Anointing of the Sick: Celebrated after masses when requested or by appointment.

Marriage: Engaged couples should contact the parish at least six months in advance of a desired wedding date.

Bulletin: Submissions for bulletin must be submitted to Kim Primo ten days prior to the first date of inclusion. Bulletin items will be included two weeks prior to event with advanced notice included 2 months prior. All submissions subject to approval/editing.

Look for the Children's Worship Bulletins in the Vestibule, Commons/Narthex areas of your parish.



Roof Restoration Update – Phase 2 Begins in July!

We are grateful to share the next step in our journey to preserve the beauty and integrity of St. Mary Star of the Sea Catholic Church.

Phase 2 of our Roof Restoration Project is now underway. Our contractor has determined that the weight of the slate and plank board roof deck has caused the decorative rafters to act as a lever—resulting in the visible "kicked up" slate along the roofline.

To address this issue and ensure the long-term stability of our roof, the following work will be completed:

- Removal of existing slate from the bottom eight feet of the roof
- Removal of necessary plank board to access decorative rafters
- Furnishing and installation of new 8-foot decorative rafters
- Reinstallation of existing plank board
- Installation of new synthetic underlayment
- Reinstallation of slate
